This event brought services across Bedfordshire together to inform and promote their work in each individual field. Since our initial launch we have been working hard to promote our aims and objectives for 'Direction for Bedfordshire' across a number of our partner agencies. Engaging with staff and attending team meetings has not only given us an opportunity to market our concept, but also get a better understanding of what our partners can provide throughout Bedfordshire and their latest projects. This has also given us a chance to put partners in touch with each other to merge services and create a holistic support system.
