Clients can create a profile and post asking for donations in their local area. In some cases, members of the community have also offered their services to transport items but generally they will need to be collected

Facebook Marketplace also sells second-hand items for discounted prices. Many items will need to be collected from the seller

Applications will only be accepted from recognised social organisations on behalf of a family or individual. Applications are considered every 6 weeks

		<p>Buttle UK award grants to of up to £2,000 for children and young people impacted by recent crisis to provide items and activities. They only accept applications from frontline professionals (e.g. a charity, housing association/support, school or public sector organisation), and who...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• have carried out at least one home visit</li> <li>• have made a full assessment of the children's / young person's needs</li> <li>• are working directly with the children / young person</li> </ul> <p>If successful, the professional will need to manage the grant spend, upload receipts, and complete an evaluation survey. Families and young people cannot apply directly to us.</p>
<b>Grants</b>	<b>BBC Children in Need Emergency Essentials Programme</b>	<p><a href="https://www.familyfundservices.co.uk/emergency-essentials/">https://www.familyfundservices.co.uk/emergency-essentials/</a>  BBC Children in Need Emergency Essentials Programme supports children and young people who are facing exceptionally difficult circumstances and is delivered by Family Fund Business Services. The programme provides items that meet a child's most basic needs such as a bed to sleep in, a cooker to provide a hot meal and other items or services critical to a child's wellbeing.  All applications must be made by a registered referrer, and they aim to process applications within 10 working days.</p>
