Our Director, Stuart, and Operations lead, Neill, both attended Peterborough Prison this month to see how they manage their Departure Lounge for Residents and the impact their outreach Centre, Outside Links, has had. They were both very impressed with the professionalism shown by staff and how residents from the prison were Released on Temporary License to help at the Centre. Stuart and Neill will be discussing this at the next Reducing Reoffending Board on the 2nd November.

Tommy attended a professional's day which Emmaus Carlton held, where numerous agencies including Penrose, Bedford Homeless Partnership, the rural policing team to name but a few, were invited to attend the Emmaus site and listen to the excellent work that they do and ethos they live by. It was a great opportunity for us to make some more good contacts with agencies as well as being able to tour the site and see just how things work for the companions that reside there.

At Wilmott Dixon construction Ltd they are currently partnering with JTL Training to deliver an 8-week construction traineeship for young people aged 16 to 18 who live in Luton, Dunstable, and Central Beds and want to know more about the opportunities and career pathways within the construction industry. They have projects at the L&D hospital, Chiltern Vale project in Dunstable and at Wixams in Bedford. We have further meetings set up to discuss how we can develop these opportunities for our clients.

Nicky attended a meeting with Helen Jenkins who is the Partnership and Integration Manager at Jobs 22, they are running the government Restart Employment Scheme in Bedfordshire & Bucks. Helen secures partners for wraparound support services to help address some of the barriers that their participants have to the job market this could be Health, Mental Health, Disabilities, Ex-offenders etc. They run the restart program where people who have been working with the job Centre for 12-18 months can sign up to the program (which is up to 12 months long). Jobs22 will also be attending our forums.
